



## HOSTING THE SUMMIT FUELS YOUR CHURCH INITIATIVES

Hosting the Summit in your church improves the leadership capacity of your staff and volunteers, facilitating Kingdom transformation in your church, community and world. These are the top 7 outcomes\* and behaviors expressed by leaders who hosted the Summit.

### Revitalizes Relationship with God

# 23%

of church leaders report a revitalized relationship with God because of attending the GLS.

### Inspires Generosity

# 36%

of attendees have given money to impact the community in the past two years because of inspiration from the GLS.

### Drives Church Growth

# 28%

report the size of their church has grown because of leadership skills, vision or inspiration from attending previous Summits.

### Motivates Volunteer Leadership

# 15%

of church participants volunteered for a new church leadership position because of the GLS.

### Improves Quality of Teamwork

# 82%

of the 96% of church leaders who applied team-building skills learned at the GLS "agree" or "strongly agree" that those teambuilding skills allowed their organization to increase the quality of their work.

### Energizes Evangelism

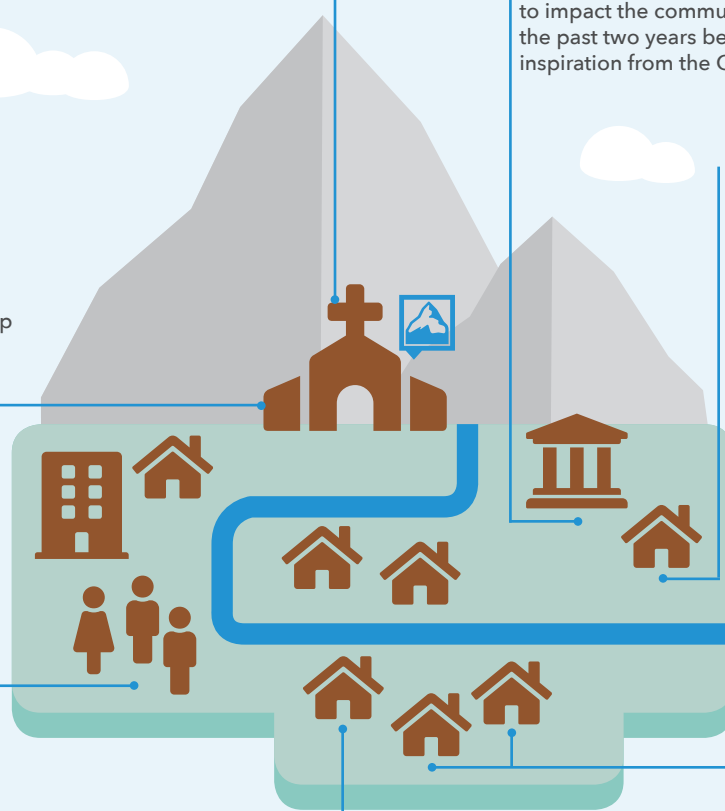
# 31%

report that the GLS inspired them to share the Gospel in the past 2 years and provided concrete data about the means, scope, and results of their evangelistic efforts.

### Impacts Community

# 60%

cited concrete ways they served the poor, helped youth, educated others, comforted the hurting and fought injustice.



\*Independent research conducted by Excellence in Giving. 2,268 repeat participants from the United States reported how previous Summit experiences impacted their lives and organizations. This sample size produces a 2.9% error margin with a 99% confidence level that the results reflect the average outcomes for all 2017 Summit participants.
